Wi-Fi Ready

Personal Apartment Wi-Fi

Your apartment comes Wi-Fi ready when you move in, with no need for additional equipment.

Connect Your Devices to Wi-Fi

To get your dedicated Wi-Fi connection, you'll have to add your device to our network through our online Midco My Devices portal. You can authorize up to 10 devices per individual – including computers, tablets, phones and gaming devices.

Browser-Enabled Devices

This includes smartphones, tablets, computers and any device with internet browser capabilities.

- 1. Find and select **TheConnection** in your list of available networks. If not directed to the login site, visit **Midco.com/MyDevices**.
- 2. Enter the **username** and **password** provided to you.
- 3. The first time you connect, review the Midco Acceptable Use Policy, and select Accept to proceed.
- 4. When prompted, change your password.
 - Your password must be at least four characters long and include at least one uppercase letter, lowercase letter and a number.
 - You cannot reuse your last password.
 - Be sure to write down your new password, as you'll need it to add and manage more devices in the future.
- 5. Select **Register This Device**.

Non Browser-Enabled Devices

This includes gaming consoles and other connected devices that do not allow internet browsing.

- 1. Find and select **TheConnection** in your list of available networks.
- 2. Visit Midco.com/MyDevices
- 3. Enter your **username** and **password** provided to you.
- 4. The first time you connect, review the Midco Acceptable Use Policy, and select Accept to proceed.
- 5. When prompted, change your password.
 - · Your password must be at least four characters long and include at least one uppercase letter, lowercase letter and a number.
 - You cannot reuse your last password.
 - Be sure to write down your new password, as you'll need it to add and manage more devices in the future.
- 6. Follow the on-screen prompts to add your devices. Enter the following information:
 - a. Device Description: Enter the nickname you'd like to use for your device.
 - b. Device ID: This is the media access control (MAC) or Wi-Fi address of your device. It is an alphanumeric ID in this format: A1:B3:E5:19:6F:BB.
 - c. To add your device, select **Add** or **Save and Continue**.

You'll receive a confirmation message when your device is successfully connected to the network. Repeat these steps with any additional devices you'd like to add.

Wired Ethernet Connectivity

If you need to have an Ethernet port for a gaming system or other device, we have you covered. Your bedroom comes with one built in. You'll need to add the MAC address of any wired devices you connect using the instructions above.

Cable TV

Midco Basic Cable – with more than 70 channels, including local networks – is also available in your living room as part of your rent. This includes the full suite of HBO® channels. You'll find one HD digital adapter already in your living room when you move in.
